Matthew 25:14-19

¹⁴ "For the kingdom of heaven is like a man traveling to a far country, who called his own servants and delivered his goods to them. ¹⁵ And to one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one, to each according to his own ability; and immediately he went on a journey. ¹⁶ Then he who had received the five talents went and traded with them, and made another five talents. ¹⁷ And likewise he who had received two gained two more also. ¹⁸ But he who had received one went and dug in the ground, and hid his lord's money. ¹⁹ After a long time the lord of those servants came and settled accounts with them.

Make it Personal

- 1. You have the key to greatness
- Gifting doesn't feel like a gift to the gifted. It comes natural.
- There's a unique ability that God has given you that you can do better than other people

Q— what comes natural to you?

Proverbs 18:16—"Giving a gift can open doors; it gives access to important people!"

- People never discover what their gift is because they are fixated on a gift that God didn't give you
- Q— Recall a moment in your life where you encountered a struggle? In hindsight were you able to identify why you went through that struggle?

Proverbs 25:2 - "It is God's privilege to conceal things and the king's privilege to discover them.

- Q— Do you consider your job to be your ministry? How?

 - B) Will people pay you for it?
 - C) Do gifted people think you're gifted?
 - D) Where do you find favor?
 - E) What grabs your attention that you can't turn off?
- 3. Your key requires some assembly.
- gifting isn't just gifting... It's hard work.
- Luke 16:10—"If you are faithful in little things, you will be faithful in large ones. But if you are dishonest in little things, you won't be honest with greater responsibilities."
- these overnight successes have YEARS of work behind them.

Q—What does it look like for you to be faithful in growing and developing God's gift in you?
